The Wright Clinic is a not-for-profit, community-based dental clinic managed by the London Community Dental Alliance (LCDA). The first of its kind in London Ontario, the clinic launched on April 6, 2021. A team of dentists, dental hygienists and dental assistants work collaboratively from a health equity framework to provide dental care to individuals facing barriers, such as income or housing insecurity. The Wright Clinic is funded through donations, community grants and in-kind contributions by volunteer dental professionals, including dental specialists, dental assistants, and dental hygienists.

The LCDA was formed in 2018 in response to the growing demand for an accessible dental clinic to support the oral health needs of vulnerable Londoners. Dr. Ken Wright is the catalyst who gathered a small group of dedicated community partners and dental professionals to actualize his vision of an accessible dental clinic that operated 5 days a week to serve London's most marginalized community members.

DR. JACQUELINE LÓPEZ GROSS, DDS, MSC, FRCD (C)

Born in Caracas Venezuela. She received her Master's of Science degree in Endodontics from the University of Toronto in 2018 and is a Fellow of the Royal College of Dentists of Canada. Prior to her specialty training she completed an Advanced Program in Endodontics at New York University in 2012.

She received the award for "Best Oral Research Presentation" at the American Association of Endodontics Annual meeting in 2018 and received a Research Award from the International College of Prosthodontics and IFEA in 2019. She is now dedicated to private practice and to supporting the community as a teacher and a volunteer. Currently she is a lecturer in the Graduate Endodontic Program at University of Toronto, an Adjunct Clinical Professor at the University of Western Ontario and a volunteer specialist at The Wright Clinic.

Graduated from University of Witwaters and in South Africa in 1971 and obtained a higher diploma in dentistry from the university of Pretoria in 1980. He emigrated to Canada in 1987, Joining the Faculty of Dentistry at Western and taking up the position of Director of dentistry at the South West regional center. A long term care facility for adult challenged individuals. In 1994 he was appointed course director for the first year operative dentistry lab until 1996. He ran the endodontic program at Western until 2001. He was course director of the second year endodontic sim clinic program until 2021, as well as supervising the endodontic clinic one day per week. He returned to private practice in 1997 restricting to endodontics. He volunteers at the Wright Dental clinic providing endodontic services. Manny has presented numerous courses in Endodontics both in Canada and South Africa. He is a Member of the ODA, American association of Endodontics, Canadian academy of endodontics, International Association for Dental Traumatology, and the American college of dentistry. DR. CLIVE FRIEDMAN, BDS, CERT PED DENT, DIPLOMATE AAPD, FAAPD, FIADH, FICD

Dr. Clive Friedman was born in Johannesburg and has trained and worked in South Africa, Israel, England, USA and Canada. He obtained his specialty in pediatric dentistry in New Orleans and has a special interest in persons with disabilities, behaviour, risk management, motivational interviewing, babies and early intervention of sleep disordered breathing. He has been president of the International Association of Disability and Oral Health and the Academy of Dentistry for Persons with Disability and is currently a Board Member of CSDH. He has been active in organizational dentistry in Canada at both a federal as well as provincial level. He continues to act as a consultant in numerous capacities to both these organizations. He is currently a member of the ICC (International clinical Council for FOP) and is on the Board of Tin Soldiers. He is also currently involved in the creation of a Gnathic App to help identify early retrognathia and the Pacified App which helps parents choose the correct soother for their children.

Clive is frequently invited to lecture both locally and internationally on disabilities ,risk assessment, behaviour, minimum intervention dentistry, autism, special needs, trauma informed care, fop, tethered tissues and motivational interviewing. Many of his articles have been published in dental and special needs journals internationally. Clive recently retired from full time pediatric practice and now practices very part time as well as focuses on many facets of volunteer work within the oral health sphere.

After practicing for five years in London, as a general dentist, he ventured forward and received his Diploma in the Specialty of Paediatric Dentistry from IUPUI (Indiana University) in Indianapolis, Indiana in 1984. He practiced full time paediatric dentistry from 1984 until 2014 when he had to take early retirement. He taught at the Schulich School of Dentistry for 41 years in various roles but finished off as adjunct clinical professor in the Division of Paediatric dentistry and retired from the school in 2018. From 1992 until March of 2023, he was the Dental Director of the Cleft Lip and Palate and Craniofacial Anomaly Team at Thames Valley Children's Centre in London, Ontario. Olaf served on the Executive of the London and District Dental Society from 1993-1998. He has authored or coauthored several scientific articles and has participated in Operation Walk Canada since 2016, as the paediatric dentist on its mission to Antigua, Guatemala.
